Student Scholarships

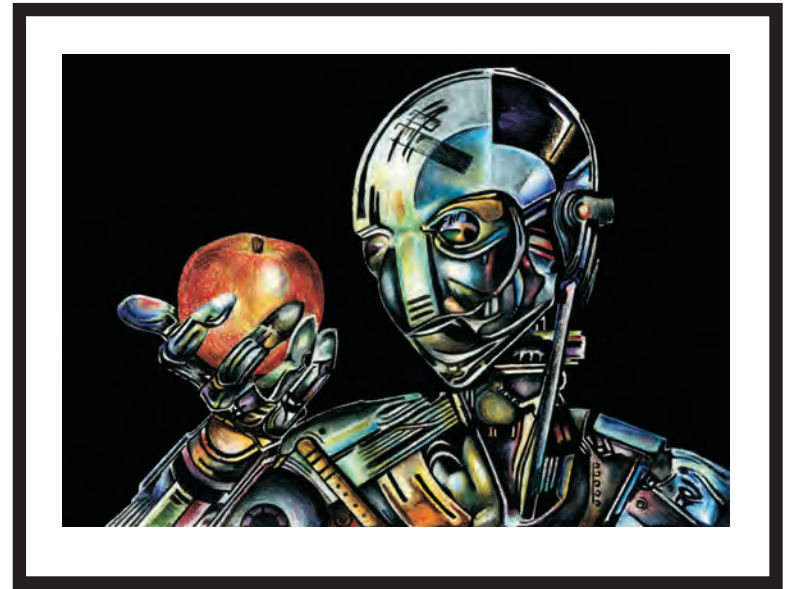

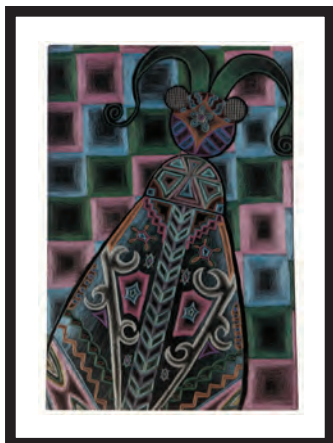
